Installing FastReport Desktop on Windows

To install FastReport Desktop, download the installer from your [Control Panel](#) and run it.

If User Account Control (UAC) is enabled on your system, confirm the prompt to allow the program to run.



A browser window will open automatically. Log in using your account credentials.






Note: If you see messages like "Not available" or "A previous version is already installed", it likely means an older version was installed using a different installer. To proceed with the update:


1. Close the installer.
2. Uninstall the existing version via **Windows Settings > Apps > Installed apps**.
3. Re-run the installer.

If the issue persists after removing all previous versions, contact [technical support](#).


Next, specify the installation folder (or keep the default):



When ready, click **Next** to begin installation. The process may take a few minutes, depending on your internet speed.



Once installation completes successfully, click **Finish** to close the installer.



Offline Installation

If the target machine has no internet connection, follow these steps:

1. On a computer **with internet access**, run the installer and complete the installation.
2. Navigate to the installation directory and copy the following files to removable storage:
 - o `setup.exe`
 - o All `.dat` files
3. Transfer these files to the offline machine and run `setup.exe`.

The installer will detect the lack of internet connectivity and display the following screen:

Select **"Use manual registration"**, then copy the key from the **"Registration information"** field and send it to [technical support](#) to request an activation code.

Once you receive the activation code, paste it into the **"Registration code"** field and click **Next**. The installation will then proceed as described above.

Uninstalling FastReport Desktop

To remove FastReport Desktop, use the standard Windows uninstall process:

1. Open **Settings > Apps > Installed apps**.
2. Locate **FastReport Desktop** in the list.
3. Click **Uninstall** and follow the prompts.

Installing FastReport Desktop on Linux

To install FastReport Desktop, download the appropriate installation package from your [Control Panel](#). Packages are available in the following formats and architectures:

- Package types: `.deb` or `.rpm`
- Architectures: `x64` and `arm64`

Choose the package compatible with your Linux distribution:

- `.deb` - for Debian-based systems (e.g., Ubuntu, Linux Mint)
- `.rpm` - for RPM-based systems (e.g., Red Hat, CentOS, SUSE, Fedora)

Installing the Package

Note: Administrative privileges are required for installation.

You can install the package in one of two ways:

1. **Graphical method:** Double-click the downloaded file (if supported by your desktop environment).
2. **Command line:** Use your distribution's package manager. Examples:

Ubuntu / Linux Mint:

```
sudo apt install ./fastreport-desktop-professional_en-2026.1.0-x64.deb
```


Fedora:

```
sudo dnf install ./fastreport-desktop-professional_en-2026.1.0-x64.rpm
```

After installation, the **FastReport Install/Remove** tool will appear in your application menu. Launch it to complete setup.


Step 1: Begin Installation

Select **Install components** and click **Next**.



Step 2: Choose Components

Select the components you wish to install and click **Finish**.




Once complete, all FastReport Desktop tools will be ready to use.

Uninstalling FastReport Desktop

To uninstall FastReport Desktop, use the **FastReport Install/Remove** tool from your application menu.


Step 1: Begin Removal

Select **Remove components / uninstall program** and click **Next**.



Step 2: Confirm Removal

Select the components to remove and ensure **Uninstall program completely** is checked. Then click **Finish**.



The system will prompt for your administrator password and proceed with the uninstallation.

Manual Uninstallation (via Terminal)

If needed, you can remove the package directly using your system's package manager. The package name is:

`fastreport-desktop`

Ubuntu / Linux Mint:

```
sudo apt remove fastreport-desktop
```

Fedora:

```
sudo dnf remove fastreport-desktop
```

Removing User Data

FastReport Desktop stores user-specific data in the following directories. Delete them manually if you want a **complete cleanup**:

- Configuration files:

```
~/.local/share/FastReport
```

- Reports, tasks, schedules, and logs:

```
~/FastReport
```

Warning: Removing these folders will permanently delete your saved reports and settings.

Minimum system requirements

Minimum system requirements for installing and using FastReport Desktop Windows:

- OS: Microsoft Windows 7 and newer, Windows Server 2012 and newer;
- CPU: 1 GHz;
- RAM: 512 MB;
- You also need the installed [.NET 6 runtime](#).

Minimum system requirements for installing and using FastReport Desktop Linux:

- OS Linux: deb/rpm package support, can run .NET 8 and AvaloniaUI 11.1.0 applications. Tested with Ubuntu and Fedora;
- CPU: 1 GHz;
- RAM: 512 MB;
